The successful applicant will have the following skills and experience;

Essential

Knowledge, Experience and Skills

Experience working in a contraception and sexual health service and/or working in a service providing termination of pregnancy.

- Pro choice.
- Working within a safeguarding framework with vulnerable at risk clients
- Teaching and mentorship in a clinical setting
- Ability to communicate effectively,
- Ability to identify and quickly defuse challenging situations.
- Ability to understand boundaries, and work in a sensitive, confidential and non-judgemental way.
- Able to work effectively as a member of a team and contribute effectively with internal/external multi professional teams, demonstrating effective leadership skill

Desirable

- Experience working to Patient Group Directions
- Experience of using IT systems to input, store and retrieve client data
- Theatre experience (if applying to work in a surgical unit)

Specific requirements

- A satisfactory Disclosure and Barring check
- Commitment to the aims, values of NUPAS
- Able to work to the service rota, to meet the needs of the service, including weekends /evenings

Qualifications

Essential

- Current Nurse and Midwifery Council (NMC) registration as a Registered Nurse (Sub part 1 of the NMC register)/Registered Midwife
- Recognised qualification in Contraception and Sexual Health (or successful completion of the (N)DFSRH within 12 months of commencing post.
- Faculty of Reproductive Sexual Healthcare (FSRH) Letter of Competence or equivalent qualification in Sub-dermal contraceptive implants (*or successful completion of SDI training within 12 months of commencing post*)

Desirable

- Mentorship/teaching or assessment qualification Sexually Transmitted Infections Foundation (STIF) Course (*or successful completion of the STIF course within 12 months of commencing post*)
- Faculty of Reproductive Sexual Healthcare (FSRH Letter of Competence in intrauterine techniques i.e. IUS/IDU fitter)
- Recognised qualification in Independent/Supplementary Prescribing
